

UK Tuition Rates & Terms

as at 01/05/2018

1. Tuition is charged at £30.00 per hour from Monday to Friday between 9:00am and 6:00pm. Any tuition that starts before 9:00am or ends between 6:00pm and 8:00pm is charged at £40 per hour, as is tuition on a Saturday. Sunday tuition, and weekday tuition after 8:00pm, may be available by separate negotiation.
2. We reserve the right to charge (at the standard tuition rate) for time beyond the norm required for lesson preparation and/or student feedback or marking. This will be agreed prior to the lesson or course of tuition.
3. A 10% discount will be given for any block booking of 10 or more lessons made and paid for in advance.
4. 24 hours' notice is required to cancel a session. Cancellation after that time is chargeable at the normal rate.
5. For couples wishing to learn together, one student is charged at the normal rate and the 2nd student is charged at £10 per hour. The total charge is invoiced to the nominated student who is responsible for payment. If one of the couple cannot attend a lesson, please give us at least 24 hours' notice before the lesson. If notice is given, the remaining student will be charged at £30 per hour. If notice is not given in time, the full amount will be charged (see point 4). For groups of more than 2 students, please see our group rates & terms on the following page.
6. Payment for invoices is due immediately on receipt though 7 days grace from the invoice date is given to allow time for payment to be made.
7. If tuition is not at our premises or by Skype, mileage is charged at 45p per mile. If travel time equals or exceeds 15 minutes in either direction, it may be charged at half the normal tuition rate.

UK Tuition Group Rates & Terms as at 01/05/2018

1. A group is defined as 3 or more students learning together.
2. Group sessions are taught in 'terms' of 4 weeks of 1 or more lessons per week on pre-agreed dates. Lessons may be of 1, 1½ or 2 hours duration as agreed in advance with the group and each term will be invoiced and paid for in advance.
3. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, the teacher has to cancel a lesson, a replacement date will be arranged with the group.
4. A new student may join an existing group on payment of a charge equal to the proportion of untaught lessons in that term.
5. The group hourly rate is £16 per student.
